

### The Tuff Cam

This high quality rough and tumble camera can be a fantastic aid to many lessons. It has a 1.5" screen and with a hard wearing rubber outer and chunky buttons, it is easy for even the smallest of hands to operate. It can also take a few bumps and bashes which is just as well in my experience. This is both a still and movie camera with a stop and go action feature ideal for filming experiments such as plant growth stages or developing crystals. It has a 3 mega pixel resolution, which i feel is a sufficient quality for a camera of its type. It is totally child friendly and is in a very eye catching yellow, which of course makes any child within a 12 foot radius want to use it.

With this camera you can liven up many a lesson such as creating your own short movies of the Centurions in Roman Britain or for just taking pictures of your native wildlife; the possibilities are as endless as your imagination. The camera comes with soft ware and clear instructions and has a USB docking station making it easy to connect to any home computer. It is equipped with a 64 mega byte sc-card that will give you 12 mins of recording time; this however can be upgraded simply by purchasing a larger memory card. The camera itself costs £79.95 exc vat, which i feel is a very reasonable price for a camera with such capability.
